



MPTC Firearms Handgun, Rifle, Shotgun Instructor Recertifications Protocol - 2024

GENERAL INFORMATION:

MPTC Instructor certifications for Firearms Handgun, Rifle, and Shotgun expire on 12/31/24. Instructors are required to (1) requalify at a range, (2) attend a 4-hours classroom training, and (3) apply for instructor certification renewal before 12/31/24.

Note: This does not apply to NEW Firearms Instructors who completed training after May 1, 2024.

Note: Instructors must make their own arrangements for, and complete requalification(s) at a range *prior* to enrolling in the classroom training.

The in-person classroom training (4-hours) will be offered three times per month across the state at MPTC facilities between **September and November 2024**.

REQUIRED PROTOCOL:

- Instructors are required to complete their requalification(s) at a range prior to enrolling in the classroom portion.

Note: Instructors must make their own arrangements for requalification(s).

Note: Make sure you obtain a copy of your completed Qualification Sheet. You are required to attach it to your enrollment for the classroom portion (see sample on next page).

- Enroll in class in Acadis Training portal and complete in-person classroom instructor recertification training. You must attach a copy of your completed and signed MPTC Firearms Instructor Qualification sheet when enrolling.
- Upon successful completion of weapon systems recertification requirements for Handgun, Rifle, Shotgun, instructors are required to renew their certification in the Acadis training portal on or before 12/31/2024.
